	Response #1 More reading quizzes. There weren't as many quizzes on the reading as I expected there to be.
	Response #2 I think the pre-class quizzes were an effective way in encouraging students to read and apply the concepts they read, so I would definitely recommend continuing those. I think maybe giving these quizzes IN class as opposed to before class would encourage students to actually read the book, as opposed to scanning the chapter for the few specific questions on the quiz.

Response #3	I do not feel that there necessarily needs to be some sort of incentive, but perhaps some sort of extra credit given to students who volunteer to answer a certain question or two in class based on the required readings for that day.
